## SSSBRC RANGE RULES

Prior to the commencement of the day's session NO RIFLES are to be taken to the firing point until called by the range officer and red light is on.

No one is to go forward firing point until the green light is displayed.

The range officer is the only person to control the lights.

No rifle is to be handled whilst anyone is forward of the point.

The rifle must be pointed at your target when closing the bolt.

Stop means cease fire, if called, follow the range officer's instructions.

Report any crossfires or issues to the range officer.

When you have fired you last shot, fit a safety flag and/or remove the bolt from your rifle, you may then leave the firing point quietly, leaving all equipment until cleared by the range officer.

Keep talking behind the firing point down to a volume that will not disturb other shooters.

Mobile phones should be turned off or to silent.

Targets will be changed before removing any equipment, except to the last detail of the day.

You have 30 minutes for this target.

Time commands will be -

Two minutes to settle in.

Start

10 minutes to go

5 Minutes to go

1 Minute to go

Stop.
